Your child's caregiver uses the pain scale together with examining your child. Your child's caregiver may use any of the following pain scales: Faces pain scale: This scale consists of different faces, from happy (no pain) to sad (a lot of pain). Your child may not want to do his daily activities because of the pain. Functional dyspepsia is upper abdominal pain that does not go away when your child has a bowel movement. Irritable bowel syndrome (IBS) is abdominal pain that goes away when your child has a bowel movement.Chronic Abdominal Pain in Children - What You Need to KnowGeneralized pain or pain over more than half of the belly. Your child can have this kind of pain when they have a stomach virus, indigestion, gas, or when they become constipated. Cramp-like pain is likely to be due to gas and bloating. (It's named for one of the physicians who first identified it in 1955.) Opioid (aka narcotic) pain relievers such as morphine are often prescribed to children with severe injuries or chronic pain caused by cancer or other illnesses.
