Many people come to the United States to get an education, a degree and then to continue on with their lives through employment visas. They get the F-1 Visa and

Therefore, the official must be convinced to grant the reinstatement. This is done through persuasive arguments in the cover letter as well as the supporting declaration. It is done through properly explaining why you went out of status in the first place and how you have

rectified the situation and will be able to maintain proper status in the U.S. at school. This is a very important application as it is one of the few that simply forgets all the time you were out of status and illegal and allows you to move forward with your life and education if granted.
